
### Continuous full-time service determination

I, Danna Vale, Minister for Veterans' Affairs for and on behalf of the Minister for Defence, under paragraph 5R(1)(a) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* (the Act), determine that the Act applies to, and in relation to, a person included in the class of persons who are appointed as official War Artists or official War Photographers and who provide services as War Artists or Photographers in support of Operation FALCONER on or after 13 April 2003, as if that person was, while rendering such service, a member of the Defence Force who was rendering continuous full-time service, for the purposes of this Act.

### **Determination of Non-warlike service (OPERATION SOUTHERN WATCH)**

I, Danna Vale, Minister for Veterans' Affairs for and on behalf of the Minister for Defence:

- a. revoke the determination made by the Minister for Veterans' Affairs for and on behalf of the Minister for Defence date 29 June 2000 in relation to OPERATION SOUTHERN WATCH, and
- b. determine that service rendered as a member of the ADF serving with the US element of the coalition force operation to patrol the Iraq No-Fly-Zones on OPERATION SOUTHERN WATCH, in the Area of Operations specified below during the period 29 September 1999 to 12 January 2003 is non-warlike service for the purposes of subsection 5C(1) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*.
  - The area of operations comprises Iraq, Saudi Arabia and Kuwait.

- b. determine that service rendered as a member of the ADF serving with the UK element of the coalition force operation to patrol the Iraq No-Fly-Zones on OPERATION BOLTON in the Area of Operations specified below during the period 13 May 1999 to 12 January 2003 is non-warlike service for the purposes of subsection 5C(1) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*.

### **Determination of Warlike service OPERATION CATALYST**

I, Danna Vale, Minister for Veterans' Affairs for and on behalf of the Minister for Defence, determine that service rendered as a member of the ADF allotted for service on or after 16 July 2003 on OPERATION CATALYST in the specified area below is warlike service for the purposes of subsection 5C(1) of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986*.

- The Specified Area comprises the total land areas, territorial waters, internal waterways and superjacent airspace boundaries of Iraq, Kuwait, Bahrain, Qatar, United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia north of 23 degrees North latitude, the Persian Gulf and the Strait of Hormuz.
