



VETERANS' ENTITLEMENTS ACT 1986

DETERMINATION OF HAZARDOUS SERVICE

1, Gordon Neil Bilney, Minister of State for Defence Science and Personnel, pursuant to paragraph 120(7)(b) of the Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986, determine service in the Defence Force of the following kinds to be hazardous service for the purposes of that Act, namely -

- (1) Service with Allied Forces providing humanitarian aid to Kurdish refugees in Iraq and in the area of Turkey south of latitude 38° north;
- (2) Service afloat after 8 June 1991 and before 1 April 1996 in Royal Australian naval or allied naval units deployed in the following areas: the waters of the Arabian Gulf, the Gulf of Oman, the Northern Arabian Sea, the Gulf of Aden and the Red Sea bounded by to the south and east by the following coordinates:
 - a. 25° 00' North - 61° 50' East
 - b. 20° 00' North - 61° 50' East
 - c. 11° 50' North - 51° 17' East;
- (3) Service with the United Nations Special Commission for the Destruction of Weapons of Mass Destruction in Iraq; whilst actually in Iraq;

being service commencing on the day of arrival in an area specified above for the purposes or of a type specified above, and ending on the day of departure from the specified area.
